Mar Yosip the Bishop was ordained Metropolitan by the Patriarch, His Holiness Mar Poulus Shimon. In 1933, when His Holiness Mar

Eshai Shimon was exiled from Iraq by the order of the Iraqi government, His Beatitude Mar Yousip Khnanisho took on the overall leadership of the Church of the East in Iraq and the east. In 1973 when His Holiness Mar Eshai Shimon tendered his resignation, His Beatitude Mar Yousip Khnanisho was appointed as the representative of the Patriarch of the Catholicos Church of the East and was appointed by the Iraqi government as the supreme Head of all the Assyrian people in Iraq. Mar Yosip departed this earthly life to life eternal on the afternoon of Sunday third July 1977 on the day of Mar Tooma the Apostle. He was laid to rest on Wednesday 6 July in the church of Mar Gewargis of Doura in Baghdad with His Beatitude Mar Narsai Elias, the Metropolitan of Baghdad officiating accompanied by His Grace Mar Daniel the Bishop of Kirkuk and many priests and deacons. A gathering of twelve thousand people that included believers from all affiliates in Iraq were present to farewell this gracious high prelate. Also joined in this service were many other Christian denominations of Baghdad together with many Moslems and government representatives headed by the representative of the president of the Republic of Iraq Mr Ahmad Hassan Al-Bakr and representatives of His Holiness the Pope of Rome. Also present were His Holiness Mar Poulus Shiko the Patriarch of Babel and Chaldea and His Beatitude Mar Sankhiro Zkha of the Assyrian Orthodox Church and Mar Andreus Sana.

The twelvth was His Beatitude Mar Yousip Khnanisho, the Metropolitan, he died in Baghdad on Sunday 3 of July 1977 and was laid to rest in the church of Marte Mariam in New Baghdad.

This position of Metropolitan of Roostaqa in Shamsdin which was also known by all the church adherents as the protector of the Elam See and was the only position with authority to ordain a Patriarch in the Church of the East in the event of a vacancy occurring.

The Late Mar Yosip Khnanisho was aware, even as a young man, of the challenges ahead, and had accepted the calling from the lord to serve his people and his Church, he was such a dedicated man that at very young age, he memorized all the holy rites and prayers of the Holy Apostolic and Catholic Assyrian Church of the East. He was taught by the Late Rev Rehana (his father's uncle) who had wide knowledge of Aramaic and church theology was also fluent in Turkish and Russian languages. Many other students studied under Rev Rehana in the Mar Ishu monastery for priestly church ordination. Many Bishops and priests of this Metropolitan See had graduated from this school.

Mar Yousip was ordained a Deacon at twelve years of age then in 1912 was ordained priest after he had mastered the Aramaic Language, attained a high level of education in scripture and theology .

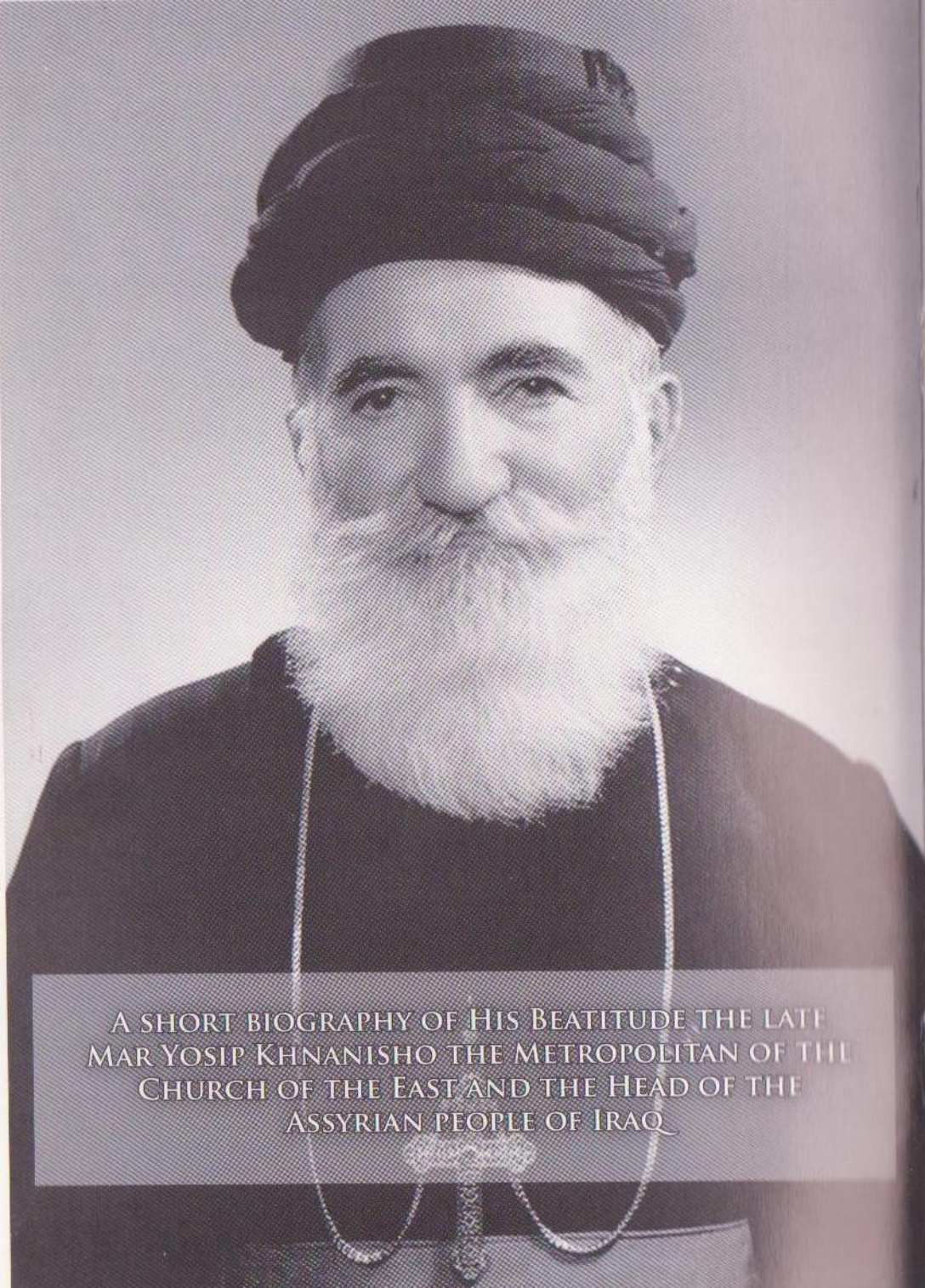
In 1914 at the beginning of the WW1 Mar Yosip (Priest) was sent by Mar Iskhaq Khnanisho as a delegate to a Patriarchate conference in Qutchanis .The conference was set to discuss the forthcoming changes that were likely to happen in the nation and in the Church as a result of the war. While at Qutchanis Rev Yosip Khnanisho was ordained Bishop on 10 July 1914, by His Holiness Mar Benyamen Shimon. The young Bishop Mar Yosip remained in Qutchanis as Patriarch's assistant until 1916, the year Assyrians made the exodus out of their Homeland as a result of the war. During this period he acquired the expertise in Leadership among his people who had arrived in Baaquba. On December 2nd 1918, in the city of Baghdad, Mar

A SHORT BIOGRAPHY OF HIS BEATITUDE THE LATE MAR YOSIP KHANISHO THE METROPOLITAN OF THE CHURCH OF THE EAST AND THE HEAD OF THE ASSYRIAN PEOPLE OF IRAQ

It has been long standing tradition that the church fathers would be ordained out of a number of nominated families that were well known for their faith and their self sacrifice for their church and nation. This order of succession was to go through the uncle to his eldest nephew.

Mar Yosip Khanisho was dedicated to the church and to the tradition of the hierarchy of the church, his mother had been fasting from all flesh and animal products until his birth in 1893.

His Beatitude (Mar Yosip) was of the household of Mar Khanisho family, the Metropolitan of Roostakea, he lived in the village of Isho in the District of Shamsdein in Turkey in the neighborhood of the Mar Isho monastery that was built early in the fifth century. A succession of twelve Metropolitans had been ordained from the Mar Khanisho family who are well known for their holiness, their diligence and their faithfulness to the church leadership. The tombs of five of them are known to be in the Mar Isho monastery. The whereabouts of another three are not known because of the alterations that had taken place in the monastery at various times. The ninth Metropolitan died in Bohtan after his return from a pilgrimage to the Lord's tomb in Jerusalem and was laid to rest in the church of B'nai Shmoonie in the village of Charokhina. The tenth died in Baloolan when visiting Targawar, and was buried (as per request of the parishioners of the church in Baloolan) in the church of the Apostle Mar Tooma in Baloolan and his tomb can be found there today. The eleventh was His Beatitude Mar Iskhag Khanisho who died in Karmanshah in Iran during the exodus from Turkey with his people. A shrine has been build over his tomb that is visited by many in that country.

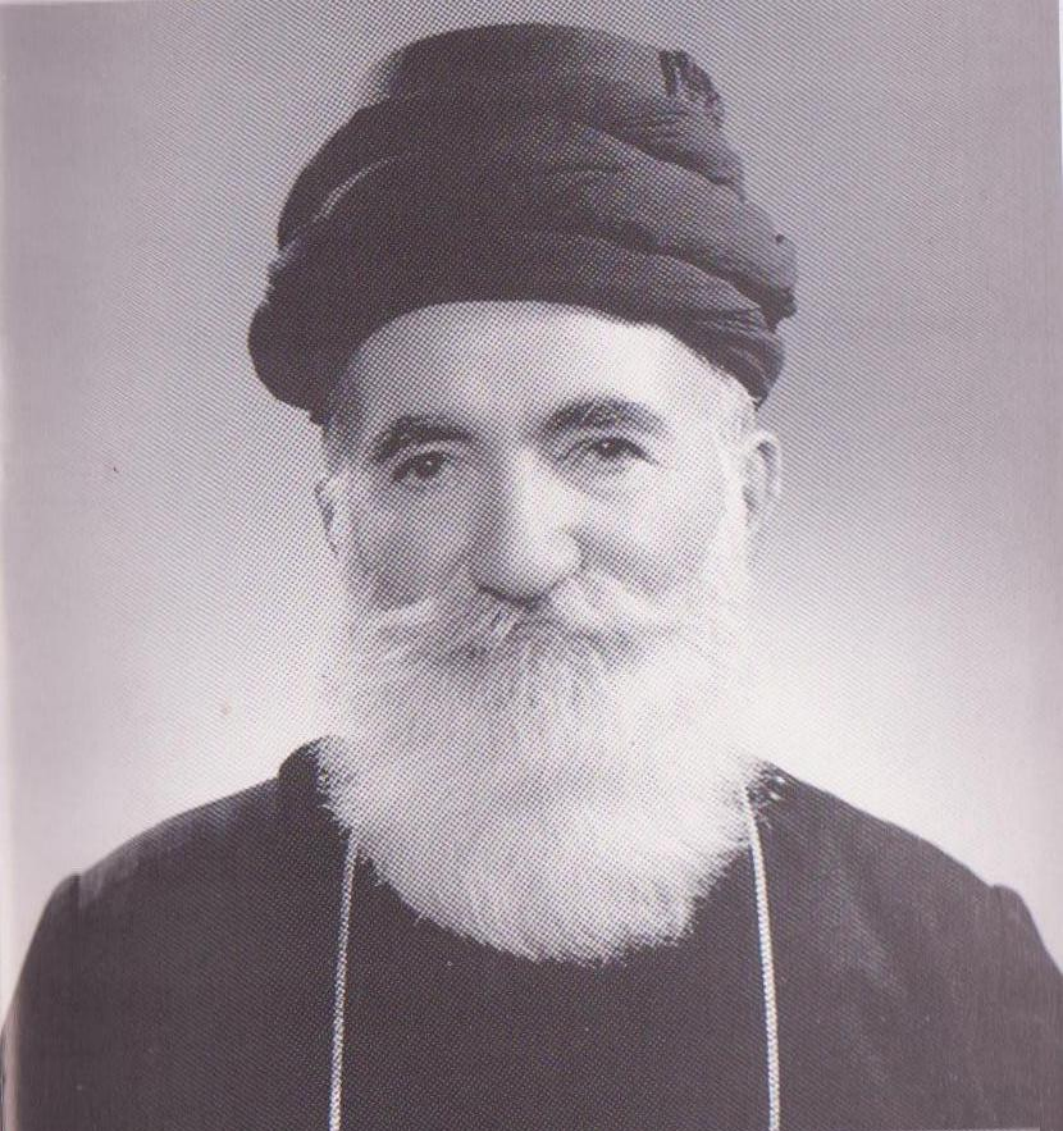
